NEW RESPONSIBILITIES

Our responsibilities have grown over the year we have been back from Guatemala and been working every week out of the CAM headquarters office in Dallas. I am now responsible throughout all CAM fields for every CAM family going on Home Assignment, or furlough, throughout their time for renewal and refreshment in the States.

Also, since January 1 we are caring for our new missionary families who have been accepted into CAM after a thorough application and interview process. We are part of the team in headquarters who thoroughly evaluate these new people, so we get to know them very early in the process. Plus, having been through that process four years ago, we still remember the major transition as your prior life is retooled into a very different life of cross-cultural service. Any major transition of life brings stresses, doubts, excitement, anxieties, and other focus points of hard changes, and we are able to help in personal knowledge of what it is like, availability in friendship, and counsel.

This responsibility of caring for families in transition lasts from their acceptance into the mission until their arrival in their field of service, a period of a few months to a few years, as each family raises their support team of churches and friends. Sometimes a family races through the process of support raising and personal preparation. Other families take more extended time and need our help through accountability and counsel.

So, the mix of families we directly supervise changes over time. Currently there are 27 and therefore we are challenged with lots of phone calls, emails, and appointments. I struggle with wanting to spend more attention with each family. However, Dianne and I love our opportunities to help others.
